1.0 THE INSTITUTE: -

The Government College of Engineering, Amravati was established in the year 1964 and is affiliated to Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University . The College is situated on Gadgenagar-Walgaon road and is spread over 105 acres of land. The institute is about 14 KM from Bandera Railway Junction on Howrah-Mumbai railway line. It is about 3 KM from Amravati Bus Stand. The Amravati city is very well connected by rail and road. It is about 150KM from Nagpur , the second capital of Maharashtra State . The nearest airport is Nagpur.

Since its inception, the college had developed into a premier institution in Vidarbha Region catering to the needs of industry, public and private sector undertakings, government and private technical institutions and the society in general.

During 44 years of its existence, the college has produced over 9000 graduates and 830 post-graduates and 27 Ph.D. students. The institution has produced eminent engineers who are occupying key positions in government and private organizations. The college is proud of its illustrious alumni. In pursuit of achieving its objectives, the college offers various UG / PG programs, conducts training programs, seminars, conferences, research and development, training, consultancy, inspection, monitoring of other institutes in the region and host of other activities. The institute has been awarded Academic Autonomy for UG & PG programs and started implementing from academic session 2006-07. Second batch of M.Tech. and first batch of B.Tech. under autonomy have passed out recently .

2.0 UG PROGRAMS:-

Since 1964, the institution has attracted meritorious students for admission to undergraduate and postgraduate programs. Currently, total intake capacity of seven B.Tech. programs is 390 with details as stated herewith:-

The institute also offers Five Post Graduate Full Time and Four Part Time programs under autonomy, which are approved by AICTE, Government of Maharashtra and Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University. The students of this institute have consistently excelled in several competitive examinations like GATE, CAT, GRE TOEFL and competitive examinations conducted by several PSUs.

3.0 CAMPUS AND INFRA-STRUCTURE: -

The institute has separate building for each department. Each department has well equipped laboratories. The other amenities provided are Canteen, Gymkhana, etc. Currently institute has two boy's hostels namely "Sahyadi" and "Satpuda" accommodating nearly 360 students. In addition, a separate girl's hostel namely "Jijao" accommodating nearly 200 inmates. All rectors and wardens stay in the college campus and are available to solve the problems of students. Each hostel has a separate mess. The institute has also student co-operative stores, which offers high quality material to the students at very competitive prices. Entire campus is connected by fiber optic LAN and 10 MBPS lease line connection is available for surfing. The facility is also being extended to Hostels.

4.0 LIBRARY: -

The institute has a well established library with open access, currently situated in a recently constructed and beautiful building. The library has a valuable collection of textbooks and reference books having number more than 71439 under General category and Book Bank schemes. The library also subscribes 55 Indian and 14 Foreign Journals, and also E- Journals facility of Science Direct, IEEE, ASME, ASCE, covering 312 journals on-line which are used by faculty and students. In addition, library is a member of NISCAIR at I.I.Sc Bangalore through which students and faculty can procure the technical papers. The library has collection of several CDs, learning resources,

videocassettes and other educational aids. Library is fully computerized and all transactions are made using bar coded system with open access to the students. Eklavya Channel facility is available in library to avail the facility of transmission of recorded courses of IIT Professors.

6.0 RULES FOR ADMISSION TO M.TECH. PROGRAMS

6.1 GENERAL : PROGRAMS AND INTAKE

[1] These rules shall apply for admission to all postgraduate programs.

[1.1] The structure, syllabi, examination scheme and duration of programs shall be as prescribed by Senate of the Institute. The full details are available on website of the institute. Duration of Full Time programs is 2 years and Part Time programs is 3 years.

[1.2] The intake to various programs is as approved by AICTE, and Govt. of Maharashtra from time to time. All rules pertaining to admissions, eligibility criteria, caste reservations, fees, scholarships, cancellation of admission, all academic matters ,etc, will be governed by the rules as prescribed by these authorities as well as by Senate of the institute.

6.2 DETAILS OF PROGRAMS OFFERED:

Note: The number of seats offered for admission will depend on availability of specialized faculty members in the concerned departments. The time table schedule will be finalized by concerned department depending upon available time slots.

6.3 RESERVATION OF SEATS AND DOCUMENTS: -

- [1.1] All original documents will be required at the time of interview and admission. The students have to submit the proof of passing qualifying examination on or before the date of admission.
- [1.2] If sufficient number of sponsored candidates are not available, these seats will remain vacant.
- [1.3] Any program will be run only when minimum number of qualified candidates are available.
- [1.4] For SC/ST reserved seats , candidates belonging to respective category from any region of the country are eligible for admission. But for other categories such as VJ, NT1, NT2,NT3,OBC and SBC candidates belonging to the State of Maharashtra only will be eligible for admission.

The distribution of Non-Sponsored General and Reserved Category seats is:

Candidates claiming to belong to backward class will be required to produce a certificate to that effect from appropriate authority. Candidates belonging to all reserved categories except SC and ST will be required to produce a current

certificate that his/her parents do not belong to creamy layer as per relevant orders of the Government.

- [1.5] Reserved seats for backward class candidates will be offered to the candidates in the respective category in the first round strictly on merit as specified in these rules elsewhere. If sufficient numbers of candidates are not available in any reserved category, the vacant seats may be offered to the eligible candidates of other reserved category. And even after this, if the candidate is not available in respective category, then it will be offered to open category.
- [1.6] No reservation is provided in the sponsored category. However, preference will be given to the candidates of reserved category in the case of equal merit.
- [1.7] Separate applications will be required if a candidate desires to consider his application for the different programs, if eligible.
- [1.8] Curriculum structure, the detailed syllabi , Rules and Ordinances, rules and regulations for examination , etc are available on the web site of the institute. The candidates should go through the same before taking admission.

6.4 AUTHORITY FOR ADMISSION: -

The Principal shall be the authority for granting admission to PG programs. However, candidate's admission shall remain provisional until the approval from Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University as regards to their eligibility .

7.0 ADMISSION OF NON-SPONSORED (GENERAL and BC QUOTA) CATEGORY CANDIDATES FOR FULL TIME M.TECH. :-

[1] **Eligibility:** The candidate fulfilling eligibility requirements that are specified by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University for admission to a particular PG program will be considered for admission to the respective programs . Minimum marks is 55% in Bachelors degree from an AICTE approved institution or equivalent (AMIE).

[2] Admission Procedure:

[2.1] Admission will be effected according to merit list prepared on the basis of valid GATE score in the respective branch only.

[2.2] When enough GATE qualified candidates in the respective branch are not available, the vacant seats will be offered to non-GATE candidates as per merit, based on total marks secured out of 100 as indicated below: -

i) Entrance test	70 marks
ii) Interview / viva voce	30 marks

Total Performance	100 marks

[2.3] Candidates securing less than 40 marks out of 100 indicated above shall not be eligible for admission.

[3] Entrance Test : (For non-GATE candidates)

[3.1]. A written test shall be conducted for non-GATE candidates to fill up the vacant seats, if any , after admitting all GATE qualified candidates.

[3.2] Syllabus for the entrance test shall be as prescribed for GATE for the respective qualifying undergraduate programs.

[3.3] Date and time of the entrance test and the admission programs is given in the schedule of activities.

[3.4] Candidates having valid GATE score in one branch will not be considered for admission to another branch. However, if a candidate desires that he/she be considered for admission to another branch against vacant seats, he/she will be required to appear for entrance test and interview / viva voce in full. The admission of such a candidate will be effected if he/she is otherwise eligible for admission to that branch. as per University rules.

[4] Distribution of Seats: - The distribution of seats amongst open and BC categories and the procedure to be followed in effecting admission shall be as per rules 1.3 to 1.6.

[5] Stipend / Scholarships: A stipend may be made available from AICTE funds depending upon the financial sanction from AICTE as approved from time to time. These scholarships will be offered to the GATE qualified candidates only, strictly on the basis of GATE score MERIT and continue to receive the same, provided they fulfill the conditions as prescribed by AICTE from time to time .

[6] For receiving PG scholarships, a candidate must have qualified in GATE. However, a GATE qualified candidate does not automatically become eligible to receive a scholarship. Stipendiary candidates will have to take 8 hours of teaching load of undergraduate programs.

8.0 ADMISSION OF SPONSORED CATEGORY CANDIDATES TO FULL TIME PROGRAMS

[1] Eligibility: The candidates fulfilling eligibility requirements that are specified by this institute as well as Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University for admission to a particular PG program from an AICTE approved institution will be considered for admission to the respective programs. Minimum marks is 55% in Bachelors degree or its equivalent (AMIE) .

[1.1] In addition to the above, the candidates will have to fulfill eligibility requirements as prescribed by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University from time to time.

[1.2] The candidates must have a minimum of 2 years of full time work experience in a registered firm / company / industry / educational or research institute / any Government department or Govt. Autonomous organization in the relevant field in which admission is being sought. However, the candidate has to attach “sponsorship certificate” on the later head of employer in the format available in the brochure with an application form.

[1.3] Only those candidates who at the time of admission are employed in an organization will be eligible for claiming seats against sponsored category.

[2] Admission Procedure:

[2.1] Candidates will be considered for admission based on total marks secured out of 100 as indicated in Para 2.2.and 2.3 of item 7.0.

[2.2] If the total performance of the candidates is comparable then the preference shall be given to candidates who are GATE qualified and those who are serving in Engineering College / Polytechnic / and any industry in that order.

[3] Stipend / Scholarship: The sponsored candidates are not eligible for any stipend / scholarship.

[4] Reservation of Seats: No reservation in the sponsored category. However, preference will be given to the candidates of reserved category in case of equal merit.

[5] Entrance Test: The institute will conduct a written entrance test for all the sponsored candidates. The procedure for this is as per Para 2.2.and 2.3 of item 7.0.

9.0 ADMISSION TO PART TIME M.TECH. :

[1.1] Candidates who possess Bachelors degree in the respective or allied branch of engineering / technology specified by the concerned University from an AICTE approved institution with at least 55% marks will be eligible for admission to respective courses.

[1.2] The condition of minimum percentage of marks may be waived for those candidates who are teachers either in Engineering Colleges or in Polytechnics and joined before 20/09/1989 provided they are eligible for admission to that course as per University rules.

[1.3] In addition to above, the candidate will have to fulfill the eligibility requirements prescribed by the University, if any.

[1.4] The candidates must have minimum of 2 years of full time work experience in a registered firm/ company/ industry/ educational and /or research institute/ any Government Department or Government Autonomous Organization in the relevant field to which admission is being sought. The candidate should be working in the jurisdiction of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University or within 100 km from the institute.

[1.5] The candidate should produce an undertaking from the employer that he will be spared for attending the classes as per prescribed time table and they have no objection for his pursuing the studies.

[2] Admission Procedure :

[2.1] Candidates will be considered for admission on merit based on total marks secured out of 100 as indicated below: -

[2.2] Candidates securing less than 40 marks out of 100 indicated above shall not be eligible for admission.

11.0 CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION AND REFUNDS OF FEES:-

Note:-

1. Amount of Security/Caution Money Deposit is to be refunded entirely to candidate.
2. For the calculation of amount on the pro-rata basis, one month shall be treated as one unit e.g. if the candidate cancels the admission on third day after start of the academic

session **and** the seat is filled on/before the cutoff date, then cancellation amount will be, total fees/12 or Rs. 1000/-, whichever is higher.

3. The candidate who has secured admission under reserve category and has not paid any fee, shall pay Rs. 1000/- as cancellation charges.

12.0 HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION:

Though hostel is available, accommodation is not guaranteed for PG students.

13.0 CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE: -

[1] Student while studying in the institute, if found indulged in any anti-national activity, contrary to the provisions of Acts and Laws enforced by Govt., any activity contrary to rules of discipline will be eligible to be expelled from the college without assigning any notice by the Principal.

[2] If any of the statements made in the application form or any information supplied by the candidate in connection with admission later at any time is found to be incorrect or false, admission will be cancelled, fees forfeited and will be expelled from the college by the Principal and prosecuted, if deemed necessary. An appeal against the order of expulsion may be referred to the Director of Technical Education, Mumbai whose decision in such cases will be final.

[3] All the candidates are required to give the undertaking in the format specified.

14.0 RULES : -

[1.0] All rules regarding eligibility, fees, stipend, scholarship, etc will be applicable as and when modified by Senate of the Institute, AICTE, Govt. of Maharashtra, DTE and Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University from time to time.

[2.0] For receiving PG scholarships, a candidate must have qualified in GATE. However, a GATE qualified candidate does not automatically become eligible to receive a scholarship. Stipendiary candidates will have to take 8 hours of teaching load of undergraduate programs.

[3.0] As per the decision of senate of the institute, M.Tech. student is expected to have minimum knowledge of few courses relevant to their M.Tech. specialization. In case the admitted students are found to have no competency in the relevant courses, they have to appear for additional audit courses as decided by the concerned department.

[4.0] The department are at liberty to decide the academic schedule of PG programs as per their convenience.

[5.0] If the candidate is unable to complete his dissertation within prescribed schedule of the program, he/ she has to re-register for the semester for the extended period of submission of his/ her dissertation by paying required semester fees.

15.0 ADMISSION PROGRAM:

The eligible interested candidates should download the application from the institute website, obtain print and submit the same duly filled in application form along with supporting documents and registration fees in the office of the institute up to **15th July 2010 (Thursday)** on all working days during working hours. The registration fees of Rs. 800/- (Eight Hundred) for General category and Rs. 400/- (Four Hundred) for SC/ST category students. The fee must be paid in the form of DD drawn in favour of “**The Principal, Government College of Engineering, Amravati**” payable at Amravati (MS) or cash to be deposited with cashier. Incomplete or ambiguous applications shall be rejected.

Note: All original documents will be required at the time of interview and admission. The students have to submit the proof of passing qualifying examination on or before the date of admission.
